ANSONIA - Wakelee Avenue residents and business owners received an early Christmas gift Dec. 18.

That's when the city held its official grand opening of the renovated main thoroughfare on the west side.

Mayor David S. Casseti addressed the crowd of about 50 gathered outside Roma Pizzeria, 150 Wakelee Ave.

He thanked numerous companies and individuals involved in the reconstruction of the street as well as the state Department of Transportation and Ansonia Public Works Department.


Casseti said, "The project was a full depth reconstruction, including new granite curbing, curb ramps, sidewalks, crosswalks, driveway aprons, pavement markings, drainage structures/pipes and utility pole relocations along with 120 new decorative lights, and geometric improvements at the intersection of Wakelee [Avenue] and Franklin [Street]."

He added that more than 6,500 cars pass through Wakelee every day.

The restaurant provided pizza, soda, coffee, and cookies for everyone to enjoy after the event.
