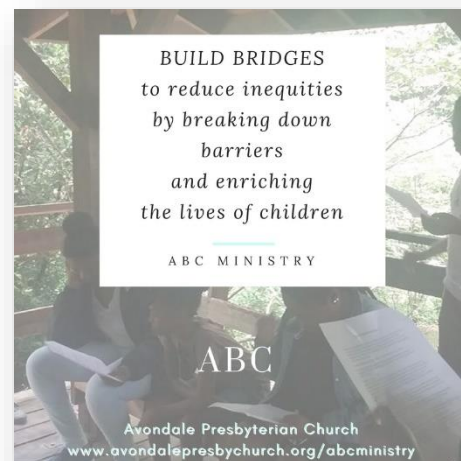
TRAINING

Bethlehem Center training is conducted at the main campus at 2705 Baltimore Avenue. The training takes about 45 minutes and covers strategies to use when working with children and teens, information on child abuse and neglect, and logging volunteer hours.

GET INVOLVED

After application and training, there will be opportunities for you to volunteer! Current volunteer opportunities

- Volunteering with K-5 age children will be located at the Southview Recreational Center located at 1720 Vilma Street, and include reading, helping with arts and crafts, and helping with homework.
- Volunteer opportunities with the Avondale teen program include helping with homework, tutoring and mentoring.
- Administrative volunteer help is also needed for those who can bring their own laptop. Administrative work will include filing, printing, help with simple spreadsheets, helping develop a list of community resources and contacts, among other things. Most of this work takes place at the Southview Recreational Center (1720 Vilma Street) under the direction of Georgett Johnson. (Bethlehem Center training is not required for this opportunity.)
