HOW YOU CAN GET INVOLVED

There are so many important and meaningful ways to get involved and support the Walton County Christian Learning Center. Please consider partnering with us to change lives through the Gospel in one of the following ways:

Give: The WCCLC receives no money from the government and relies completely on donations from churches, organizations, businesses, and individuals. We are a 501©3 non-profit organization and all gifts are tax deductible. There are several different ways that you can financially support the Christian Learning Center:

Online Giving: You can do this easily through our website (www.wcclc.org). From our homepage, simply click the drop-down tab in the upper right-hand corner and then click the "Donate" link. On the donate page, you will see a button that says, "Donate Online Now!". Clicking this button will take you to our online giving portal. From here, simply follow the directions on the page and your contribution will be sent directly to the WCCLC.

Mail-In Giving: You can make checks payable to Walton County Christian Learning Center and mail to P.O. Box 678 Monroe, Ga 30655.

Become a Monthly Sponsor: You can commit to sponsoring a CLC student for \$42 a month. You can do this online or through the mail.

Text to Give: You can text "Give" to 678-831-3199 to set up a one time or a reoccurring donation.

Support: A portion of your purchases at places such as Kroger, Amazon Smile and Great Harvest Bread Company (throughout the month of March) go to CLC when you designate WCCLC as a recipient and the Legacy State Bank has a donation box for CLC in their drive thru during the month of March. Also, consider creating a donation fund via Facebook for others to donate to CLC in celebration of a special occasion (such as a birthday).
