



## STEPS TO APPLY FOR FINANCIAL AID

If you wish to receive Financial Aid, here are the steps you need to complete:

1. FEDERAL STUDENT AID ID (*Formerly Federal Student Aid PIN*)

2. FREE APPLICATION FOR FEDERAL STUDENT AID (FAFSA)

This application is sent directly to the Federal Processor. After processing, a Student Aid Report (SAR) is sent to the student, and an Institutional Student Information Record (ISIR) is electronically sent to the Financial Aid Office, provided our Title IV school code ( **037844** ) is listed on the FAFSA. We advise you to complete your FAFSA as soon as possible.

There are two ways to complete the FAFSA:

- b. Directly through the Financial Aid Office or Library, should you need assistance.
