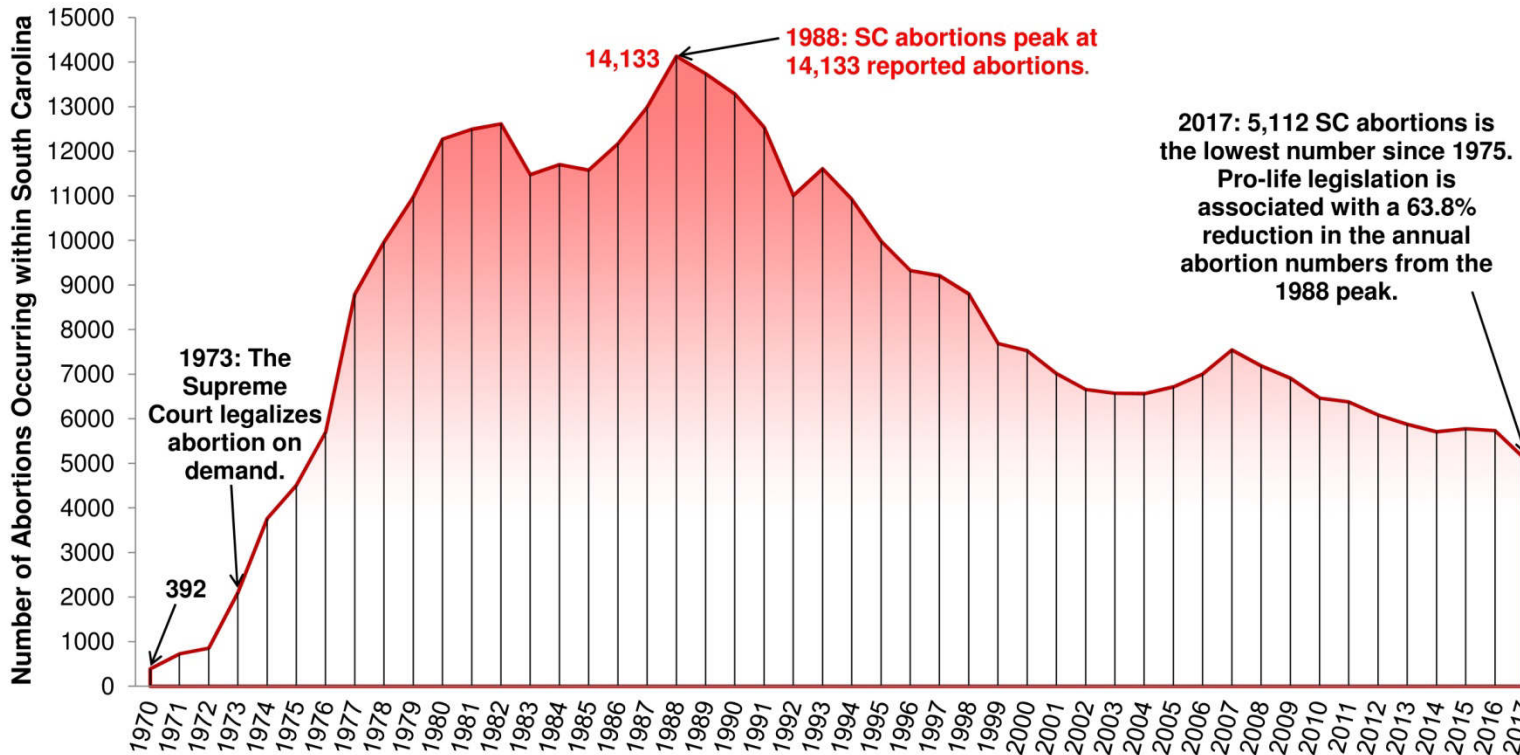


Saving babies' lives in South Carolina's most notorious former abortion facility.
