You must contact the Safety Officer for the vehicle and equipment approval in section 'D'. **The Safety Officer must sign-off on this form that your towing attachments have been checked and approved prior to your application being accepted by the Committee.**

Meantime, you might like to know a little more about the Canterbury Land Rover Owners Club (Inc.). In spite of its name, it is much more than a one make car club - in fact membership is open to all makes of four wheel drive vehicles with capabilities similar to the Land Rover, provided the vehicle is equipped with a low-ratio transfer box. We count a large number of Toyota Land Cruisers/Prados and Hiluxs, Nissan Patrols/Safaris and other similar vehicles amongst our members as well as Land Rovers, Range Rovers and Discoverys.

Our primary efforts go to the organisation of club off-road trips, but we also provide driver education, training and safety checks, sell spares, recovery & servicing equipment at discount prices and maintain quite an extensive library of books, repair manuals and videos. If you have any questions, please contact the appropriate committee member. Once a member you will have full access to these services.

Membership currently stands at between 130 and 150 members with over 40 people attending our monthly meetings at the Belfast Rugby Football Clubrooms, 18 March Place, Belfast, Christchurch. Meetings are held on the third Tuesday of each month (except for January, which is the fourth Tuesday) and run from 7:30 to about 10:00pm. At the formal part of the meeting the emphasis is on reporting on recent and forthcoming club activities and informing members of decisions made by the committee who run the club on a day-to-day basis. We may also have slides, videos or a guest speaker. This is followed by a chance for everyone to chat over a 'cuppa'.

We publish a monthly newsletter, which we hope is entertaining and informative, and this gives details about forthcoming trips and social events. It carries some advertising of 4WD-relevant products and we encourage our members to support the advertisers as they support us.

The membership form requires the signature of two existing members in support of your application. If you do not already know someone in the club, you are most welcome to come along to one of our meetings and make yourself known to one of the Committee members. If you do not currently own a qualifying 4WD vehicle or are from out of the Canterbury region you may apply to join as an **Associate Member**. If you do own a suitable vehicle you may apply to join as a **Full (Family) Member**. All full memberships include other members of your family living at the same address. Once submitted, your application will be considered at the next Committee meeting and in the unlikely event that your application is declined, your fees will be refunded in full.

A requirement of membership is that you attend a new member training programme, which consists of an evening session covering the club's rules, care and use of your vehicle off the road, recovery techniques and safety. This is followed by a one day (usually the following Sunday) practical session where you find out how best to handle your vehicle off the road to ensure you have a safe trip and can cope with the kinds of obstacles and problems encountered on club trips.

As a responsible organization we place a great deal of emphasis on both safety and the 'Tread Lightly' philosophy. We try to minimise the impact of our vehicles on the environment (and that sometimes means not venturing into particularly sensitive areas). Also, since our activities are highly dependent on the goodwill of landowners throughout New Zealand, we place great value on the access we enjoy as a club to private and public lands. We require members to respect the areas we travel in and always act in a way which ensures we will be welcome back. We also require that our members respect the rights of other people we meet in the back country, especially those on foot.

I hope you find our club a welcoming and friendly organisation and that you enjoy the opportunity to share our interest in traveling to some of the less accessible areas of New Zealand, taking only photographs and leaving only tyre prints.
