



Discover Wild Uganda safari – 9 days

(Join a Group)

Highlights: Chimps trekking, Game-drives, Boat-cruises and Safari walk

Accommodation level: Mix of budget and mid-range

National Parks included: Murchison Falls NP, Queen Elizabeth NP and Lake Mburo NP

Day 1 - To Murchison Falls National Park

Be picked by your safari guide early in the morning in Kampala. As you start your Uganda Safari you set off for the drive to Murchison Falls national park. The aim is to be in Murchison Falls in time for lunch. When you have finished your lunch it is time to experience the top of the falls. It is an amazing feeling to stand there enjoying the view and hearing the water roar. Have a relaxed evening at the lodge.

Overnight Red Chilli rest camp

Day 2 - Game-drive and boat-cruise

Get up early in the morning to meet the animals of the savanna. During this morning game-drive you can search the savanna for giraffes, elephants, lions and more. In the afternoon it is time for a boat-cruise on the mighty Nile spotting for example hippos, crocodiles and birds on the shores. Spend the night in Budongo forest (a part of Murchison Falls) to get close to the jungle.

Day 3 - Transfer to Hoima

Be woken up by the sounds of the jungle, have a relaxed breakfast and soak in the surroundings. After breakfast your guide take you to the town of Hoima. Spend some time relaxing at the hotel.

Overnight Hotel Kontiki Hoima

Day 4 - Transfer to Queen Elizabeth National Park

Be prepared for a long day in the car made easier by making a stop in a village to stretch your legs, taking a look at a tea plantation and studying the Ugandan countryside passing by the window.

Overnight Pumba Safari Cottages

Day 5 - Chimps trekking Kalinzu forest and boat-cruise Kazinga channel

After breakfast your guide takes you to the starting point of the trek in Kalinzu forest and you set off in to the beautiful jungle to see the chimpanzees. After the chimps trekking your guide meets you and takes you to the lodge for lunch. In the afternoon you are taken to the afternoon boat-cruise on Kazinga channel. This two hour boat ride is a great highlight where you for example can look for hippos, crocodiles, elephants and warthogs along the shores of the channel.

Overnight Pumba Safari Cottages

Day 6 - Tree-climbing lions in Ishasha and transfer to Bwindi

Head off to the Ishasha part of Queen Elizabeth national park in the morning. The drive there goes along an adventurous road and you have the chance of seeing baboons and elephants along the way. In Ishasha you find topis, buffaloes and search for the tree-climbing lions. The lions in this area are famous for climbing up great fig trees to take a rest. After finishing your game-drive the journey goes on to Bwindi Impenetrable national park. Enjoy the changing landscape as the car slowly climbs up towards the misty mountains of the gorillas.

Overnight Gorilla Mist Camp

Day 7 - Gorilla trekking day

You have now reached a highlight of this Discover Uganda safari; the gorilla trekking day. Your guide will take you to the starting point of the gorilla trekking in the morning and you set off for your adventure. The trek takes you through the jungle up to the point where the gorillas are and you get to spend one hour with them. When you are back from the gorilla trekking your guide takes you to the stunningly beautiful Lake Bunyonyi.

Overnight Lake Bunyonyi View Gorilla parkers

Day 8 - Relax by Lake Bunyonyi

Have a free day by Lake Bunyonyi. Here you can rent a canoe to explore the islands, take a swim (the lake is free of hippos, crocodiles and bilharzia), go for a hike or just relax with a book.

Day 9 - Transfer to Kampala/Entebbe

. Have breakfast at the lodge before starting the drive towards Kampala. Along the way, you will make a stop for lunch and at the equator for some photos on the spot where the southern and northern hemisphere meets. Continue on to Kampala /Entebbe as the end of the Uganda Safari has been reached.
