

Words on Worship is designed to help believers understand more about the nature of the God they are worshipping, while using Billingsley's worship expertise to explore many different means of worship and guide readers into a more personal understanding of how to better express their praise to the Lord. We learn that, "the purpose of our worship is to honor and bless the Lord, but the result of worship is that He, in turn, blesses us." Use Charles Billingsley's words to edify worship practices, and allow his words to bless the journey of learning how to truly, passionately worship the Lord in everyday life.
