Dear Prospective Parent,

Thank you for your interest in the Meorot program. As you know, Meorot is an innovative Judaic Studies after school program providing elementary aged students who present with learning or language difficulties with an inspired Modern Orthodox Jewish education within a supportive environment. Meorot is a community partnership between the local Yeshivot serving Great Neck.

In order to determine if Meorot is best suited to meet the learning needs of your child, we require the following documentation:

- 1) A completed and signed application form
- 2) A current Individualized Education Program (IEP) that includes:
 - a. A special education program recommendation
 - b. Related services including but not limited to speech and language services
 - c. Scores from a recent psycho-educational or neuropsychological evaluation
- 3) A recommendation letter from a principal of a local yeshiva (or a local Orthodox Rabbi if the family is not currently enrolled in a local Yeshiva)
- 4) Copies of all professional evaluations conducted for your child
- 5) A copy of your child's most recent physical examination and immunization history
- 6) A \$100.00 non-refundable application fee

All information provided will remain confidential and will only be accessible by the Meorot Program Director, Program Advisor and teachers. Please be advised that any significant withholding of information may invalidate your child's acceptance. When records are received, you and your child will be given an appointment for an interview with the Program Director. The tuition for the 2017-2018 Academic year at Meorot is \$5,000. If all application components are received by Friday, August 4th, a discounted tuition rate of \$4,500 will be offered upon acceptance.
