**Wash your hands before going into school or use hand sanitiser.**

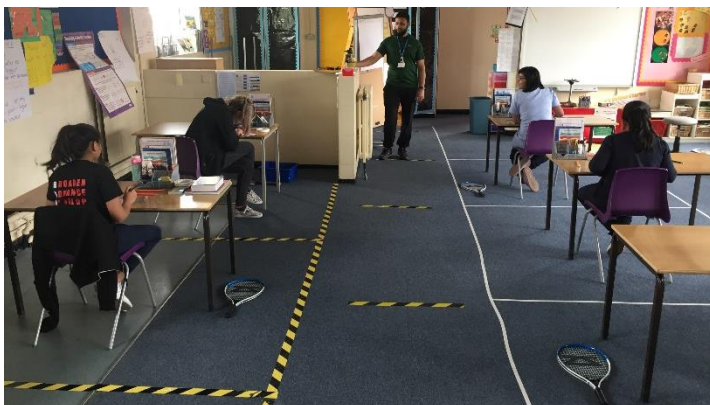




2m Social Distancing in corridors, in classrooms and around the school.

Children have PE and Playtimes in their class bubbles.



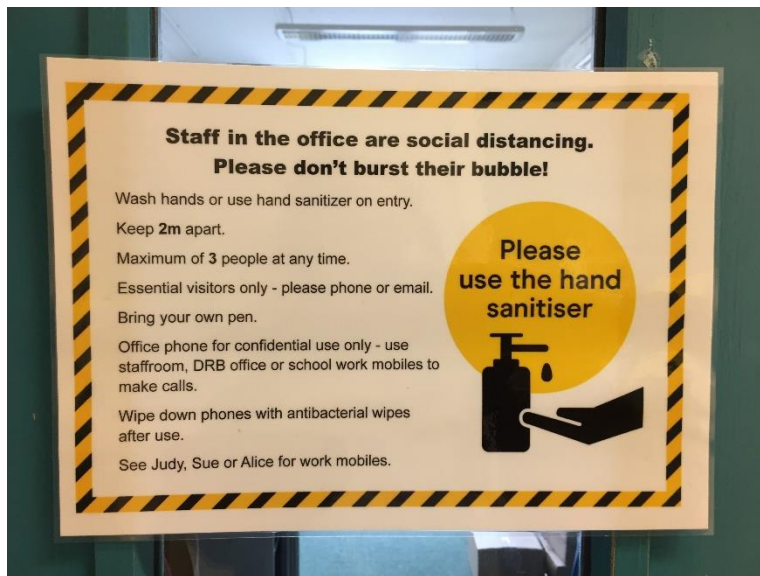
Black and yellow tape and notices help to remind us just to keep a bit of distance.

If they become ill it makes it very difficult for the school to operate and get cover.

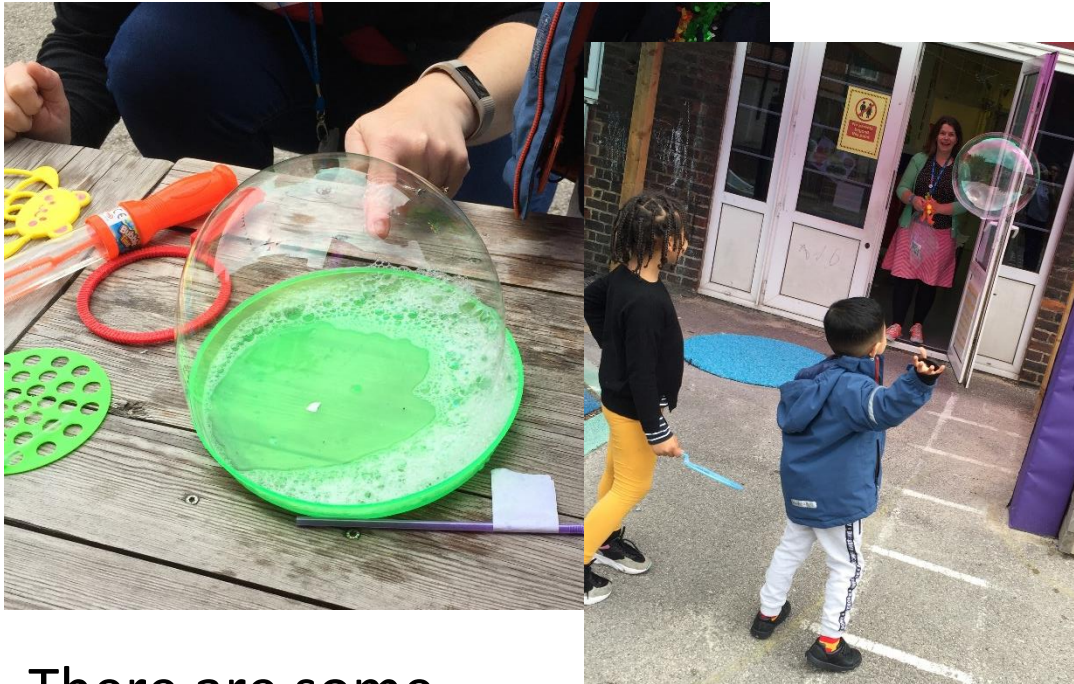
So we are all:
