## Chetwynd Chamber of Commerce demanding socio-economic Impact Assessments for the North East prior to finalization of the Section 11 and Partnership Agreements

The first of four Caribou Recovery meetings was held in Chetwynd last night, April 1, with more than 500 concerned citizens, business owners, backcountry enthusiasts, loggers, miners and oil and gas workers in attendance.

The Chetwynd Chamber of Commerce video'd the meeting on Facebook Live and as of this afternoon (April 2) it had MORE THAN 8,100 VIEWS and had been shared more than 200 times across BC and the country.

It was abundantly clear the provincial government did not do any preliminary work in regard to the economic impact to our community and our region due to these draft agreements.

The board of directors of the Chetwynd Chamber of Commerce are deeply concerned about the impacts to our community including the possibility of more than 500 job losses at just one of our mills. Those losses will trickle down and throw our community into an economic downturn that could cripple our community.

Thus we are asking that this process be halted until a proper and full socio-economic study of the entire PRRD area before the Section 11 Draft Agreement OR Partnership Agreement can be finalized. We also support the PRRD's desire to hire an independent consultant for an independent social economic impact assessment with legal council available if needed.

We support the regional district in any measures that they choose to implement leading up to the required assessments being completed, including what comprehensive consultation and mitigation measures have been implemented, and that industry and communities have an opportunity to participate in execution of those strategies.






## B.C. government gets ready for 2019 wildfire season

In the wake of two of the worst wildfire seasons on record, the British Columbia government is stepping up with more fire prevention strategies, programs and funding to help keep British Columbians and their communities safe this summer.

“We’ve taken a hard look at additional steps we can take to not only prevent wildfires, but also enhance our response on the ground during wildfire season,” said Doug Donaldson, Minister of Forests, Lands, Natural Resource Operations and Rural Development. “Our base budget for wildfire spending has increased by 58%, and we’re accelerating prevention and prevention awareness programs.”

As part of Budget 2019, wildfire management funding has increased by 58% to \$101 million annually. The additional funding will help the BC Wildfire Service add to its fire response capabilities – adding more crews, enhancing aerial capacity and including innovative technology – and spending more on fire prevention activities, including a more comprehensive prescribed burning program backed by an initial \$10 million.

New technology, including night vision goggles to better aid in early detection and response, will also be piloted this summer.

Other important advances over the past year include building stronger working relationships with communities, First Nations, the forest industry and other stakeholders. The changes support the recommendations of the independent Abbott-Chapman report.

Wildfire prevention funding initiatives include the following:

The \$50-million Community Resiliency Investment program was established in September 2018 to help local governments and First Nations lower wildfire risks around their communities. As part of Budget 2019, an additional \$10 million has been added, for a total of \$60 million. Results from the first application intake will be announced by the end of March 2019.

The B.C. government has increased funding under the Forest Carbon Initiative by \$13 million over the next three years, allowing it to take advantage of matching funding from the federal government. This money is used for reforestation and restoration initiatives that not only capture carbon, but also reduce wildfire risks. This funding is in addition to the \$235 million provided to the Forest Enhancement Society of B.C., of which nearly \$180 million has been allocated.



# 2019 JUNIOR DRAGONS DEN COMPETITION

## Who Is Eligible?

Students in grades 7 – 12 and post-secondary students

## How It Works

Students submit a business concept plan for their business idea or business expansion (in the case of an existing business) explaining their concept/expansion and why they should be chosen to compete in Junior Dragons Den.

## Short Listed Applicants

The top 5 applicants from each category will advance to the regional competitions in Dawson Creek and Fort St John. Each will be assigned a mentor from their local community. Mentors will assist with everything from start-up considerations and marketing, to coaching and presentation skills.

The top 5 applicants from each category will then work on refining their business concept into a comprehensive one-page business plan with detailed financial statements (outlines and templates will be provided).

In addition, competitors will be assisted in creating a live business pitch to use at the live competition. The Junior Dragons Den crew will assist by filming and recording each video to ensure the best pitch is captured.

## The Show

Junior Dragons will pitch their business idea in a live show format in the closest regional location – Dawson Creek or Fort St John – to a panel of local leaders (aka Dragons) in front of a live audience, including friends and family.

Winners will be selected based upon 80% input from our Dragons and 20% audience participation through voting.


