

Questions and Responses

Grade Level: 2-6

Objective: I can analyze different primary source images. I can discuss what the images represent.

Common Core: Language Arts: CCSS:ELA – Literacy. RL/RI.2-1-4-1;RI.3.7-6.7

Have students study the 'then' pictures from the Centennial Web-site:

Have each student choose one of the images.

Students will use the Question and Response Chart to analyze the chosen picture.

Students should answer all of the questions.

Come together as a class and discuss each image.

(Depending on the grade level, this activity can be done cooperatively using one image instead of independently using a variety of images.)

What do I see?

Think and Search

How do the individual details relate to one another?
How do the details complete the image?
What do these details add to the information, story, or idea presented by the image?

Creator and Me

Why did the creator choose to include the things I see?
What did he/she want me to think and feel?
What details in the image support my thinking?

On My Own

What does this image remind me of?
What would I be doing or thinking if I were a person or object in this image?
What conclusions can I draw about this image?
What more would I like to know about the information, story or idea presented by the image?
What questions should I ask to learn more?
