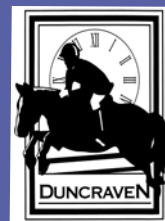

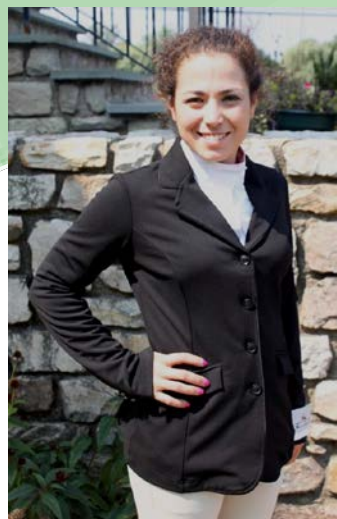

Take 295 South to Exit 3B (Scotch Rd. North). Stay straight off ramp and go straight through 3 lights; at 4th light turn left onto Washington Crossing Rd. At 2nd traffic light make a right onto Route. 579 (Bear Tavern Rd). Duncraven is 2 miles on the right.

From North (New Jersey, New York, Connecticut, New England)

From Flemington NJ, take Route. 202 South to Route. 31 South. Follow 31 South to 2nd traffic light. Make a right onto Route. 518 West. Make a left onto Route. 579 South. Duncraven is 2 miles on the left.

From NJ Turnpike

Take the NJ Turnpike South. Take Exit 7A onto 195W, follow to 295N. Take 295 North to Exit 3B (Scotch Rd. North). 2. Every class offered herein which is covered by the rules and specifications of the current USEF rule book will be conducted and judged in accordance herewith.
3. All Hunter classes will be judged on performance and soundness with an emphasis on soundness and manners unless otherwise noted.
4. The Duncraven Horse Show, Duncraven, Inc., or the committee will not be held responsible for any accident, loss or damage which occur to any rider, horse or equipment before, during or after the show.
5. The committee reserves the right to cancel, combine, change location or add any class(es) or schooling deemed necessary.
6. Failure to enter the ring within three minutes of being called will incur elimination.
7. All riders must wear proper attire including head gear at all times while mounted.
8. All pets must be leashed.
9. All fees must be paid and entry complete before numbers can be issued.
10. It is a condition of entry to the show grounds that these rules and regulations be read, understood and accepted.
11. A \$5.00 fee per exhibitor will be charged to cover the expense of having an EMT on the grounds.
