Game Night / Class Night Alternative Parking Options for Students and Faculty, 2017-18:

Below are Evening Class dates that are scheduled when there are Men's Basketball games at the Cintas Center. Alternative parking plans should be made prior to arriving to campus on these game nights.

Lots will be closed and vehicles need to be moved no later than 2 hours prior to Game Time for these lots: Cintas Center (All "C" Lots), Husman Hall, Smith Hall, Flynn Hall, Campus Services and Alumni Center.

If your class begins after 4:00pm we highly recommend allowing additional time in order to get to your classes as the volume of traffic on campus will be greater than usual.

COMMUTER STUDENT- RESERVED GAME NIGHT LOTS:

- Smith Hall and Alumni Center lots will be reserved for valid Commuter (C18 permits) and Evening (CE18 permits) permit holders only. Lots are first come first served.

FACULTY/STAFF - RESERVED GAME NIGHT LOTS:

- Innovation Center and Central Utility Plant lots will be reserved for valid Faculty/ Staff (FS19 permits). Lots are first come first served.

Other Locations - NOT RESERVED:

Unpaved gravel lots located south of Dana Avenue**, West Lot, Gallagher Center Lot, University Drive, Elet Lot, Sycamore Lot, Armory Lot, and O'Connor Center Lot. Lots are first come first served.

**These gravel lots will have parking attendants charging a \$5 parking fee to ticket holders, if you have a valid Xavier faculty/staff or student permit you are NOT subject to this fee.
