



Cathy's Rosé 2012

Tasting notes:

Salmon pink in colour, this Rosé is a pure reflection of the Pinot noir grape. A beautifully opulent nose of freshly picked red berry fruits with cherry, melon and candy-floss aromas.

A dry style of Rosé, allowing the fresh summer fruit flavours to shine through, with a soft, supple texture, finishing clean and crisp. A perfect aperitif on a beautiful spring or summer day.

Winemaking notes:

This Rosé is 'purpose built' meaning that it is crafted as a specific style rather than the saignée method consisting of bleeding off wine from an existing vat. Hence, even the grape vines from which the fruit is sourced are selected specifically for Cathy's Rosé.

The winemaker is Sarah-Kate Dineen.
