"Which of these three...was a neighbour...?" (Luke 10:25-37)

#### **JESUS LOVES PEOPLE**

When questioned, Jesus said the most important commandment was, "You shall love the Lord your God with all your heart, and with all your soul, and with all your strength, and with all your mind; and your neighbour as yourself." But how do we know who is our neighbour? Jesus told a parable about a man who fell into the hands of robbers while travelling. He was beaten and left for dead. A priest and a Levite pass by, but aren't able to help the man. Finally, a Samaritan comes upon the man. Samaritans and

Jews didn't see eye to eye on religious issues and they often treated each other contemptuously. But this Samaritan reaches out, across the boundaries of long-standing animosity, and bandages the man's wounds. Then he takes the man to a shelter, where the Samaritan pays for the man's care.

Talk about it: Jesus also said, "Love your enemies and pray for those who persecute you...For if you love those who love you, what reward do you have?" What does this mean to you?
