COMMUNION PREPARATION

We have finished our communion preparation class for this year! We spent 6 amazing weeks looking at Jesus's time on earth after his resurrection. We sifted through these stories for ways to recognize Jesus and discovered that Jesus has a wonderful habit of repeating the same actions over and over, sort of like we do in communion. When he walked to Emmaus or met the fishers on the beach, the witnesses' eyes were opened when Jesus repeated familiar actions. We also discovered that this repetition also offers a chance at redemption; Jesus gives Peter 3 opportunities to declare his love, redeeming Peter's thrice-offered denial. Communion isn't a one-time event in the same way Jesus' love for us isn't a one-time event. In communion we get another chance to ask Jesus to come work in our lives.
