

CODE OF CONDUCT

Club Jax DENVER (Herein referred to as “CJD”) is a private club governed by a set of parameters that define how all members and club officials interact physically and socially in the context of the club. This includes all club-sponsored events and group communications. All members and prospective members must read, understand and agree to adhere to these parameters.

CJD events are meant to be socially, emotionally and legally safe. To this end, **we all agree** to observe and maintain these parameters. Because we all value our group experience, and because we all understand that the parameters make that unique experience possible, we are self-policing. We do not have a need for “enforcers” and each agree to help each other monitor activity and stay within the constraints of our stated rules.

JO ONLY

- We limit activity to masturbation only.
- Oral or anal sex of any variety or degree are **NEVER PERMITTED** at CJD events.

PERMITTED PLAY

- Self and consensual mutual masturbation.
- Erotic and friendly touch, including massage.
- Showing-off/exhibitionism and watching/voyeurism.
- Parallel penis-to-penis masturbation (“C2C”).
- Frot/Frottage (rubbing bodies/penises together).
- Oral contact above the waist only (kissing, nipple nibbling, etc).

PROHIBITED PLAY

- No insertion (nothing goes inside any body).
- No anal contact (including self-stimulation).
- No docking (head-to-head foreskin sharing).
- No oral contact below the waist.

MINIMUM PARTICIPATION

Stripping to underwear only.

GUIDELINES

Warn verbally before you ejaculate. **Say it out loud with words.** You may ejaculate on yourself or on any canvas-covered surface. Avoid ejaculating on the floor and never get semen on any body opening. You may ejaculate on another member’s body **only with their explicit consent**, and you can invite others to ejaculate on you, but always avoid getting semen on the face and rectum. You should remove any jewelry, watches, rings, or piercings that might cut or tear skin.

MUTUAL RESPECT & EXPLICIT CONSENT

Remember that each member is in charge of his own body. Always ask before you touch someone you don’t know. Check it out and make sure it’s okay to play. Say “no” if you need to and always accept “no” for an answer. Never press the issue. We treat each other with mutual respect and care, as we would a brother. Cruelty will not be tolerated

DISCRETION & ANONYMIYT

Never, at any time, are you to disclose any member’s identity to anyone, either inside or outside the event venue or club. Ever! Violation of any member’s identity is grounds for termination of membership.

ILLNESS

Do not attend an CJD event if you have or suspect that you may have a disease you can spread to other members in the course of an event. This includes common colds and flu, herpes outbreaks and staph infections. HIV is **not** considered communicable in the context of club activities. HIV positive men are welcome to join the club and participate in events in accordance with our rules, as there is no evidence of transmission of the virus through mutual masturbation.

NO ALCOHOL & NO DRUGS

Never bring intoxicants of any kind, including recreational/legal marijuana to CJD events, and do not come to events drunk or high. Problem behavior will result in termination of membership and immediate exclusion from the event. *The club may, from time to time, host non-sexual social events at which alcohol may be available, and events hosted privately by individual club members may or may not include alcohol, but all J/O events hosted by CJD are designated alcohol & drug free.*

PERSONAL HYGIENE

Be clean when you attend an CJD event. Your body and hands need to be washed, teeth brushed and fingernails trimmed short, smooth and clean. Take care of bad breath and excessive body odor before entering the play space. The club provides mouthwash and hand soap at all events. Avoid use of colognes, fragrant lotions, oils or similar body/hair products.

TALKING

Excessive chatter is discouraged in the play space. Some quiet talk is okay, and hot talk is welcome at any volume. “Conversation” is another matter. Be friendly and sociable, but don’t distract fellow members in the play space.

THE RED BAND

A red band worn on the wrist during any event is a signal that this member may not be touched intimately without an explicit invitation. The red band means “don’t touch my penis.” This personal boundary **must be 100% honored by every member at all times.** Red bands are available upon request at all events at check-in.
