Firing Range Rules

- All guns to be used on the range must be unloaded & cased prior to entering or leaving the property.
- No intoxicating substances on the premises, including parking areas. Use of the premises is prohibited to anyone who has consumed such substances.
- Safe gun handling practices will be observed at all times. (NRA Standards)
- Upon entering the range area, all commands of Range Officer's or posted rules shall be followed.
- Approved eye & ear protection must be worn at all times while on the range.
 - Available for sale at the gun counter.
- You must be 21 years old to shoot a handgun & 18 years old to shoot a long gun unless accompanied by parent or legal guardian at which the age is 12 to shoot either.
- NO food or drink of any kind is permitted on the range.
- All guns used on the range must be in safe operating condition and used only with the proper ammunition included hand-loaded ammo.
- Always keep the gun pointed in a safe direction.
- Always keep your finger off the trigger until ready to shoot.
- Know your target and what is beyond.
- You can load as many rounds as you would like, and fire them as fast as you want, as long as you do so safely and accurately.
- ANY 2 SHOTS fired that strike any surface besides your paper target (i.e. ceiling, floor, target carrier, track, etc.), in any combination, will result in the Range Officer asking you to leave for the day.
- There is to be NO hand to hand transfers of firearms. If you want to pass a firearm to another shooter, place the weapon on the firing line bench and step back. The other shooter may then step forward and pick up the weapon.
- Any loading or unloading of any firearm or magazines must be done on the firing line bench.
- Drawing from a holster is allowed at the Range Officer's discretion.
- There is to be NO loaded and holstered firearms on the range with the exception of the previous rule.
- There is to be NO firing a firearm from the hip. This includes pistol grip shotguns. Unless police training advises.
- All persons, belongings, targets, ammo, and firearms are to remain forward of the LINE while
 on the range. This is to permit a fast, uninterrupted path for the Range Officer should an
 emergency arise.
- 911 Rapid Response reserves the right to reject or refuse anyone access to all facilities.

Dress Code

To ensure a satisfactory experience, the following dress code will be enforced:

- No Flip-Flops, Sandals or Open Footwear of any kind Allowed.
- Extremes in apparel or jewelry, which are distractive, disruptive, disrespectful or unsafe will not be permitted.
- Clothing or jewelry displaying: drugs, obscenities, lewd or illegal behavior, sexual overtones. etc. or any reference that is disruptive to others.
- Torn or ragged clothing will not be permitted.

3 Ways To Transport Your Pistol Weapon

- 1. Holstered or bagged.
 - a. Must remain in your holster until you're within the gun firing stall.
 - b. Must remain in your bag until you get to the range firing stall. Bag should be pointed so muzzle is down range.
- Case, UNLOADED.
 - a. Must remain in your case until you're within the gun firing stall.
- 3. Basket, UNLOADED.
 - a. Unloaded and placed into a basket. Firearm must have a colored marker in the chamber for visualization that the gun is empty or gun lock installed. Remove marker when entering the stall and re-install before leaving the stall.
 - b. No magazine in firearm while in the basket.

2 Way To Transport Your Long Gun

- 1. Case. UNLOADED.
 - a. Must remain in your case until you're within the gun firing stall.
- 2. Ground Safe, UNLOADED.
 - a. Must be pointed to the ground with a color marker in the chamber for visualization that the gun is empty or gun lock must be installed.
 - b. No magazine in firearm.

Your ammunition must be purchased from our retail store

You May Not Shoot The Following Ammunition

- Steel shot/steel slug
- Steel core
- Steel tipped (NATO M855/SS109)
- Tracer rounds
- Armor-piercing/armor-piercing incendiary
- Shotgun ammunition smaller than 00 buckshot
- Aluminum cased ammunition
- Steel cased rifle ammunition NOT purchased from the range rental office
- Hollowpoint (exception: Police agencies)
