


 Not able to point to pictures of family members Not able to follow 1 step directions (especially if modeling added) No joint attention with caregivers No intent to communicate or interact socially Fewer than 10 words (spoken or gestured) No vowel sounds 	 Not able to point to body parts on command Not able to follow 2-step verbal direction Fewer than 50 words (spoken or gestured) No verbs (spoken or gestured) Primary caregiver understands 50% or less of communication attempts Does not use m, b, p, t, d sounds More vowel sounds than consonants 	 Lack of intentional two-way communication with peers No 2-word combinations Only 1 or 2 verbs (spoken or gestured) Primary caregiver understands 60% or less of communication attempts 	 Documented medical condition known to impact speech and language development Documented hearing impairment Cleft lip or palate Big difference between what child can understand and express
