- God told Moses to record what happened

Exodus 17:14, 24:4, 34:27

- Jesus credited Moses with writing it

Exodus 19:1 “gone out”

Luke 9:28-31, 24:22

2 Possible dates

- Late date (1280 BC)
- Early date (1445 BC)

The Recurring Themes of Exodus

An expectation of holiness (Exodus 3:1-6, 19:7-11, 40:28-35)

The sovereignty of God (Exodus 3:8-10, 6:1-5, 32:7-10)

Deliverance from impossible situations

God always keeps His promises (Exodus 6:6-8)

The Glory of God

- God's Glory over Pharaoh (Exodus 9:16, 14:4, 18)
- God's Glory is the essence of who He is (Exodus 33:18-23)
- God's Glory fills the Tabernacle (Exodus 40:3-35)
