Fact of sinfulness

We sin against God

Romans 3:23 "for all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God"

Others sin against us

Matthew 18: 21 Then Peter came and said to Him, "Lord, how often shall my brother <u>sin</u> against me and I forgive him? Up to seven times?"

We sin against others

1 Corinthians 8:12 And thus, by <u>sinning</u> against the brethren and wounding their conscience when it is weak, you sin against Christ.

Fact of forgiveness

Forgive others when they sin against you

• Mark 11:25

Seek forgiveness from others when you sin against them

• Matthew 5:23-26

Foundation of forgiveness (Matthew 18:23-27)

The foundation of forgiveness is understanding how much you have been forgiven

How does God forgive us?

- Proactively
- Relieves the guilt of sin
- Not in proportion to our sorrow

Folly of un-forgiveness (Matthew 18:28-30)

- Ungrateful "went out"
- Vengeful "found"
- Arrogant "fellow slave"
- Unmerciful "100 denari"
- Unloving "choked and seized"
- Uncompassionate "threw in prison"

Fear of un-forgiveness (Matthew 18:31-35)

• v 32-35 — Eternal consequences of un-forgiveness

The unforgiving spouse can do more damage to the marriage than the original sin

Fruit of forgiveness

Forgiveness is a painful joy (Isaiah 53:3-10)

Forgiveness is the hope of reconciliation (Hosea 2:14-15)

Forgiveness prevents sin from destroying the relationship

- Psalm 103:12
