Cry of Moses (5:21)

- An increase in faith
- An increase in opposition (John 15:18-21)
- An increase in dependence on God (James 1:2-4)

When we decide to finally be free of our sin by killing our sin, expect that sin to fight back

Exodus

Complaint of Moses (5:22-23)

Moses questions God's:

- Compassion for Israel
- Calling of Moses
- Capability to deliver

When we are totally undone and empty, that is when God is ready to work (Isaiah 6:1-8)

Exodus

Compassion of God (6:1-5)

- God is in control (v 1-2)
- God keeps His promises (v. 3-4)
- God is always near (v. 5)

God allows suffering and times of temptation to grant us the joy of seeing that He alone can satisfy and deliver from sin
