The Research Centre is located on the amazing Ponza island, on the west side of the Italian coast and it host the station for migratory bird ringing activities during the spring season. The Centre is currently involved in the 'Small Islands' project (Piccole Isole) and it also collaborates with the Veterinary Medicine University of Vienna (Austria), the University of Ferrara (Italy), the Max Planck Institute for Ornithology in Germany and the Tuscia University Ecologic and Biologic Sciences Department.

The ringing activities contribute to the research on ecophysiology and phenology of migratory birds. The collected data are useful both for monitoring the conditions of birds' populations in Europe as well as to estimate the impacts of land use and climate changes on birds' trends and status.

The project will start on the 12th of March and end on the 20th of May 2016!
