## MARBLE MAZES!

### Materials Needed:

- Empty cereal box or cardboard box
- Plastic straws / craft sticks
- Scissors
- Tacky craft glue or hot glue gun
- 1 marble or small sphere

### SuperYak's Reminders!

### Instructions

1. Cut the front panel out of the cereal box or cut the top flaps off of your cardboard box
2. Glue down colorful paper to the bottom of the inside of the box
3. Cut the plastic straws into different lengths between one and five inches
4. Glue the plastic straw pieces to the bottom of the box so there is a route from side to the other
5. Once the glue dries, put your marble in one corner and rotate your marble maze to get it to the other corner!
