By signing this form, you acknowledge that the District reserves the right, to the extent allowed by law, to adopt, revise, and supercede rules applicable to registered wells and to require the owner of a registered well to obtain a permit if the well is not exempt from the District's permitting requirements and that the issuance of the well registration by the District shall not limit the District's authority to regulate the well or the production of water from the well, unless the well is otherwise exempt from such authority.
