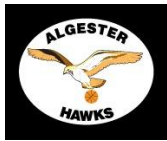
2018 OPEN DAYS AT HIBISCUS:

SOUTH WEST METRO JUNIOR COMPETITIONS:

South West Metro Basketball Inc. offers two Junior domestic "medal" seasons each year.

The first season is from February to June (School Terms 1 & 2) and the second season is from July to December (School Terms 3 & 4). Both seasons break for school holidays.

Please note: Under 7/8's and Under 9/10's have modified rules and do not play Finals.

SEASON 1:

2/3 February 2018 – 22/23 June 2018 (includes Grading and Finals)

Mixed Under 8's to Under 16 Boys (Divisions 2 & 3) and Girls (U10 - U14) play on Saturdays, anytime from 8am - 2pm, usually at Runcorn High School, Hill Rd, Runcorn or at the Hibiscus Sports Complex, 90 Klumpp Rd, Mt Gravatt.

Under 16 Boys (Division 1 only), Under 18 Boys & Friday Night Youth League Girls (U16 - U18) play on Fridays from 5pm - 10pm at either Runcorn High School or Calamvale Community College, off Hamish St, Calamvale.

SEASON 2:

20/21 July 2018 – 30 November/1 December 2018 (includes Grading and Finals) 20 July 2018 – 16 November 2018 (includes Grading and Finals for 17 & Under Boys)

Mixed Under 7's to Under 15 Boys (Divisions 2 & 3) and Girls (U9 - U13) play on Saturdays, anytime from 8am - 2pm, usually at Runcorn High School, Hill Rd, Runcorn or at the Hibiscus Sports Complex, 90 Klumpp Rd, Mt Gravatt.

Under 15 Boys (Division 1 only), 17 & Under Boys & Friday Night Youth League Girls (U15 Girls – 17 & Under Girls) play on Fridays from 5pm - 10pm at either Runcorn High School or Calamvale Community College, off Hamish St, Calamvale.

SOUTH WEST METRO JUNIOR REGISTRATION AND GAME FEES:

All registration fees must be paid online, at time of registration, securely with a credit card.

All players MUST be registered to be entered into our database and eligible to play in our South West Metro Junior competitions. NB: All South West Metro registration fees include a Basketball Queensland component and insurance.

South West Metro Registration Fee (365 Days) for Under 7/8's & Under 9/10's - \$76-50

South West Metro Registration Fee (365 Days) for Under 11/12's - Under 18's - \$117-50

Each club also charges an amount to cover the cost of trainings & South West Metro game fee costs. (Game fees are \$63 {U11-12 to U18} per game. Independent school teams can pay in cash and the Clubs are invoiced directly each week).

Most clubs also charge an annual membership fee.

All fees may vary from club to club. Please contact them (see contact details above) to find out more information on their fees.

SOUTH WEST METRO "SUPERHOOPERS" PROGRAMS:

"SuperHoopers" is an introductory skill development program, run each term, for primary school aged children 5 – 12, at various schools in the South West Metro catchment area on a week day, as well as at Hibiscus or Runcorn High on a Saturday morning.

The term cost for new participants covers weekly session costs and a Pirates "SuperHoopers" backpack, ball and singlet.

These sessions are only held during the school terms at the following locations:

Algester Primary School - Wednesdays 3.30pm - 4.30pm (Skills and Drills) commencing 31 January 2018

FUNcorn @ Runcorn High - Saturdays 8.00am - 8.50am (Modified basketball games) commencing 3 February 2018

Our Lady of Lourdes - Thursdays 3.10pm - 4.10pm (Skills and Drills) commencing 1 February 2018

Sunnybank Hills State School - Tuesdays 3.15pm - 4.15pm (Skills and Drills) commencing 30 January 2018

In Term 1, we'll also be running a program at St Elizabeth's Catholic Primary School, Tarragindi, on Fridays 3.15pm - 4.15pm, from 9 February 2018.
