Objective

- Opportunities on day 1 for defibrillation practice, arrhythmia recognition and management, ED management of VF in drowning, VT in overdose etc.
- Neonatal focus on day 2: case discussions and lectures on PDA, PPHN, SVT, cyanotic baby, murmur management, ambulatory ECG and a chance to practice on a neonatal echo simulator
