Be Kind® **STICK TOGETHER®** is a free, character education program offered to schools and youth organizations by Project Love and Duck Tape® in an effort to provide a fun and different way to explore the important social-emotional learning concepts of kindness and sticking together to combat bullying and negative behaviors. Using a combination of tools, the program mixes large group discussion, video elements, hands-on activities and a writing exercise to keep participants interested and engaged. The lesson culminates with participants pledging to “stick together” as they write their individual names on pieces of Duck Tape® and post them together on a provided poster. This poster can hold the pledges/names of up to 150-200 participants. After the program, the banner should be displayed prominently in your building as a constant reminder to be kind, caring and respectful to others.
