Sacrament Strand Year 3 “Forgiveness”

Obj 1: Lesson 1

Recognise the *Sacrament of Penance* and the *Rite of Reconciliation* as an opportunity to restore their friendship with God.

1. What is a *sacrament*? (Ways people can meet Jesus)
2. Name the *sacrament* through which people's friendship with God is restored? (Reconciliation)
3. What other name can be used for this *sacrament*? (Penance, Confession)
4. Why do people take part in the Sacrament of *Reconciliation/Penance*? (When we have damaged our friendship with people and our relationship with God)

Obj 2: Lessons 2-3

Recognise the *Sacrament of Penance* as an experience of God's forgiveness and healing through Jesus within the *Rites* of the *Sacrament*.

1. What is meant by God's forgiveness and healing through Jesus? (We can experience God's forgiveness and healing when we confess what we have done wrong and ask to be forgiven)
2. How do people receive God's forgiveness and healing during the Rite of the *Sacraments of Penance*? (We tell the priest what we have done that is wrong and we tell him we are sorry. The priest listens and then in Jesus' name and with Jesus' power and authority he actually forgives us our sins)
3. State the important parts of the *Rite of the Sacrament of Penance*. (Father greets us and we make the sign of the cross. Father reads from

the Bible. We then go to Father and tell him our sins and tell him we are sorry for what we have done. We say the prayer the “Act of Sorrow” and Father forgives our sins on behalf of Jesus. We go back to our seats and carry out our penance)

Obj 3: Lesson 4

Identify the *Sacrament of Penance* as a means of taking responsibility for personal sin and expressing sorrow, and receiving forgiveness, healing and growth.

1. What is meant by *sin*? (When we treat others badly, make poor choices about our own behaviour – these offend God)
2. What is meant by taking responsibility for personal *sin*? (Saying I did the wrong thing and I am sorry) How is this expressed in the *Sacrament of Penance*? (It helps us take responsibility for our sins because we have to own them and confess them to God)
3. How do we express sorrow and receive forgiveness in the *Sacrament of Penance*? (By saying we are sorry, asking for forgiveness, saying the prayer “Act of Sorrow” and carrying out penance)
4. What is meant by healing and growth and how is this helped by the *Sacrament of Penance*? (Our sins are forgiven by God so we are free to start again. We learn from our sins by trying to not do them again by treating others well and making good choices about how we behave so we don't offend God)

Obj 4: Lessons 5-7

Recognise that *sin* is an offence against God, a violation of *tapu* – *holiness* and human dignity and does harm to people including the sinner and that *tapu* is restored through the *Sacrament of Penance*.

1. What does *tapu* mean? (Holiness – that each human person is holy)
2. Sin is a violation of what? (*Tapu*)
3. Name an action that caused hurt to others by violating their *tapu*. (Cruel words, hitting, not playing with someone, taking their belongings etc)
4. How can you restore a person's *tapu*? (By saying sorry and asking for their forgiveness and how you would act differently next time)
5. Violation of *tapu* damages who? (The person who does wrong, the person who is hurt and God)

6. What can restore tapu? (Reconciliation)
7. Name a story that explains how tapu can be restored. (The Prodigal Son)
8. What does the Sacrament of Penance give people? (Forgiveness and restores tapu)
9. What does Hohou Rongo mean? (Making Peace)

Obj 5: Lesson 8

Identify the *Sacrament of Penance* as a community celebration.

1. Why is the *Sacrament of Penance* a community celebration? (People want to be forgiven, to make peace and to change their ways to become more loving)

Obj 6: Lesson 9

Recognise the places and prayers in the *Eucharist* where the community asks for forgiveness of *sin*, says *sorry* and makes peace.

1. Name the Rites in the Eucharist when the community asks for forgiveness of sin, says sorry and makes peace. (I Confess, Lord have Mercy, Our Father, The Sign of the Peace, Lamb of God, Lord I am not Worthy)
2. Name one prayer used in the Penitential Rite (I Confess) and one prayer used in the Communion Rite (Our Father)
3. Can demonstrate The Sign of Peace.
4. What is the name of the prayer that is said at Eucharist that recalls the words of the Roman Soldier who asked Jesus to come to his house to heal his daughter? (Lord I am not Worthy)
