### **Constitution Hill pedestrian crossing up-grade**

#### **Details of work**

- Start: 5 February 2018  
Expected completion: 16 February 2018
- Removal of existing puffin pedestrian crossing by Ash Grove that has reached the end of its service life and is due for replacement.
- Construction of zebra crossing with integrated speed table and anti-skid carriageway surfacing.
- Construction of new gullies.
- Refresh road markings.

#### **Traffic management**

##### **Week one:** 5 to 9 February

Traffic light controlled lane closure around work area.

##### **Week two:** 12 to 16 February

Temporary closure of Constitution Hill between Wall Road and Denmark Road to install speed table and related works.

Local access will be maintained during all road closures and diversion routes signed. Special signs indicating businesses remain open will be put in place where required.

Emergency services will be made aware of the closure so alternative arrangements can be made for their vehicles, if necessary. For more information about the signed diversion routes please see the enclosed drawing.
