LODGEMENT OF AN ENTRY WILL BE CONSIDERED ACCEPTANCE OF THE FOLLOWING CONDITIONS

1. The tournament will be held under Sunshine Coast Table Tennis Club rules.
2. Open to all residents of the Sunshine Coast and district or members of Sunshine Coast Table Tennis Club, Noosa Table Tennis Club and Montville/Maleny Table Tennis Club.
3. All entries subject to approval of the Tournament Committee.
4. Late entries will only be accepted at the discretion of the Tournament Committee.
5. Entry fees must be paid before playing in any event.
6. Players must report to the control desk on arrival.
7. All events will be the best of 5 games to 11 points.
8. Each match will be controlled by an umpire, whose decision with the aid of the Tournament Referee, if necessary, will be final.
9. The Tournament Committee reserves the right to combine Girls and Boys, Ladies and Men's, and age events or cancel any event with insufficient entries.
10. Age Events-
 - (a) Veterans Age Limit - 50 years of age during 2014.
 - (b) Juniors, Under 18 at 1st January 2014.
 - (c) Juniors, Under 13 at 1st January 2014.
11. Players may not enter more than 2 Singles events on any one night except for Ladies Singles and Social Singles.
12. All age events could be considered as an additional Social Event depending on the number of Social Players that enter.
13. Gradings are at the discretion of the Tournament Committee.
14. All events may be played as round robins depending on the number of entries.
15. Players not available when called may be disqualified.
16. Players participate at their own risk and no claim for injury will be considered.
17. Losing players will umpire a subsequent match. No player should leave the stadium without umpiring a due match. Any player may be called upon to umpire at any time.
18. Prizes will be awarded to all Winners and Runner-ups (if sufficient entries).
19. DHS 3 star ITTF 40mm white balls will be used.
