Summary:

Surveys were emailed to people requesting tickets for the performance. Email addresses were available from WichitaTIX using information provided by people requesting tickets. Out of the 252 surveys sent, it was a pleasant surprise to receive responses for 40% of the surveys. Typically, survey responses are about 10 percent.

Additional information and comments are available for questions 1, 5, 9 and 10. The additional information after the summary information for questions 1 - 9.

Question 5 shows that the Wichita Wurlitzer Facebook / Webpage and Friends were the primary communication channels for people learning of the event. More effort will focus on the current audience introducing Wichita residents to the Wurlitzer.

Question 6 identifies that only 16.1% of the respondents are under 50. One goal of future events is to increase the under 50 audience.

The onstage screens and chamber lighting were big hits and future shows will incorporate. There may be some modifications for silent movies. All proposed event formats had similar interest, the differences are probably not significant.



- Have more organ concerts, but I know it is expensive to getting everything ready for the concert.

 Explain what was going on up top, behind the curtains. Open the curtains and show the pipes, if possible. Briefly demonstrate and explain the console (When I press this, here's what happens, etc.) The screens were OK, a bit small. Any behind the curtain views to be shared.
- Tuesday evenings may be a bit of a challenge as I have meetings the first Tuesday of every month. I'll make it work somehow though. Hope to be able to bring grandkids and other friends when I can. They need to experience this wonderful instrument. Hope to bring them to hear Clarke and the silent movie.
- TV and radio advertising too.
- NONE! There are literally NO BAD SEATS in the house since the Mighty Wichita Wurlitzer fills every nook and cranny!!
- The video may have showed more if it were reoriented to shoe the left side of the
 organ rather than the right side. He seemed to do more stop setting changed on
 the left side of the organ. All of the tables were somewhat of a distraction.
 Consider having rows of chairs for at least part of the seating.

- Make sure any plans for replacing or refurbishing Century II include accommodation for the Wurlitzer.
