to detail. The quality of ESSE2's products are recognised internationally, the name symbolising quality, and are certified with a VetroArtistico® licence, the guarantee trademark that certifies glass artisan products crafted in the Island of Murano, in order to protect one of the most famous symbols of the “Made in Italy”. Their collections which include necklaces, bracelets and earrings can be purchased from their shop located at Fondamenta Rivalonga, 23, near the boat stop “Museo”.
