This past Wednesday, we (Lion President David Van Wart, Marinated Chair PP Don Beyer, Treasurer PP Michael Gianni and Yours Truly) met with Lions District 4-C2 District Governor Leslie A. Mize and presented our initial Millbrae Lions Donation of \$40K. Lion DG Leslie A. Mize was amazed and stressed how appreciative his Lions members of District 4-C2 are towards our club and wonderful Millbrae Community incredible support.

Part 2 – Transformation from the SCOUT HOUSE to the Millbrae Community Center (MCYC)

For 60 years the Scout House served as a home for Millbrae Lions, hosted countless dinners, meetings and ceremonies for scouting, baseball registration, and much more. In the 1980's the building was remodeled, and then in 2011 - 2013, the Lions with **tremendous support** from the Millbrae community, hundreds of donors, and Rebuilding Together, renovated the building with seismic upgrades, ADA upgrades and a new roof. In March of 2013 by three way agreement, the Millbrae Lions transferred ownership of the building, and the lease, to the City of Millbrae to be used as the Millbrae Community Youth Center.


