Modalities

- Prospective participants should download the entry form from www.toyotanigeria.com. Print out in colour. Write your name as it appears in your birth certificate.
- Complete forms properly in CAPITAL LETTERS, and bring the completed form to the Drawing Centre for vetting on the assigned date for your locality.
- A passport photograph and a CLEAR photocopy of the birth certificate should be attached to the Entry form.
- Participants must indicate on the form that they have read and accepted the terms and conditions of the contest. Read it at www.toyotanigeria.com
- Each form MUST be endorsed by the participant's parents/legal guardians.
- Artwork MUST have a title and explain in a nutshell the concept of your drawing. You will not be allowed to draw without completing the modalities above

NOTE: Toyota (Nigeria) Limited will supply the drawing papers. **You are to come with your choice artistic medium** – (e.g. water paint, colour markers, crayons, etc.) Your artwork must not only illustrate a car, but must also include a background or setting.
