### 1. Project Description -

The Village of Lewiston is proposing to building an all-inclusive playground and splash pad at Marilyn Toohey Park, located on the grounds of Village Hall, 145 North Fourth Street, Lewiston, NY 14092. The proposed playground will be designed to be enjoyable for everyone, regardless of age or level of ability and will take into account the diverse needs of the young residents in our region. The proposed playground will include traditional playground elements but will be wheelchair accessible and also feature unique audio visual elements.

The Village has been working closely with Mason's Mission (see attachments) to develop the scope of the project which is envisioned to include a slash pad. The project may be constructed in phases depending upon available funding.

The proposed playground will further develop the Marilyn Toohey Park into a summer recreation and social gathering destination, linking surrounding communities for recreational activities and entertainment that will improve the quality of life, enhance tourism and the visitor experience for those visiting the Greenway during the summer months. Similar playground projects have been completed in the region with a high level of success, including the Towns of Pendleton, Niagara, and Wheatfield as well as Olcott, NY.

### 2. Greenway Plan

The proposed project supports the Niagara River Greenway vision, goals and principles. In particular, the project will;

- Improve Access and Make Connections
- Protect and Restore Environmental Systems
- Celebrate History and Heritage
- Promote Long Term Sustainability

### 3. Project Budget -

The Village has worked closely with Mason's Mission and Parkitects to develop a project scope and budget (see attachments). It is anticipated that the funding requirements will be as follows:

Planning/Design/Administration = \$ 75,000 Construction = \$650,000 Acquisition = \$0 Operation & Maintenance = by Village ESTIMATED PROJECT TOTAL = \$725,000

In addition to seeking support from the Niagara River Greenway Commission for funding, the Village has reached out to local clubs, business organizations and citizens to support the project. The Village also anticipates receiving a Municipal SAM Grant of \$250,000 to support the project in the near future.

Village DPW forces will provide construction support and the Village will operate and maintain the playground.

### 4. Community –

The proposed project has been discussed at Village Board workshops and regular meetings. The local media has reported on the project and the Village has initiated a fund raising campaign. Thus far, the outpouring of support received validates the need and benefit of the proposed playground.

### 5. Location -

The proposed project location is on the grounds of Village Hall at 145 North Fourth Street. The site is currently being used as an open field play area along with some limited antiquated playground equipment. The Village is in the process of completing SEQR but there are no adverse environmental impacts anticipated as a result of the project and it fits within the existing and anticipated land use for the Village owned site.

### 6. Timeline -

The conceptual plan for the playground has been completed and the Village has initiated fund raising efforts. The Village hopes to complete design of the playground this winter with construction of the playground to start in the spring (possibly initial phases based on funding) so that it is available for use during summer 2019.
