Outer Banks Sporting Events appreciates your patience as we have been watching the threat of Hurricane Florence and its potential impact on our area.

As a team, we are first dedicated to safety of our participants as well as volunteers and community support. As of 10:00 this morning a state of emergency has been issued and a mandatory evacuation for residents and visitors has been ordered by Dare County Emergency Management. This goes into effect for Hatteras Island today at noon and the rest of the Outer Banks starting tomorrow at 7:00 am (Tuesday).

At this time Hurricane Florence is currently projected to be a category 3-4 storm at landfall in Southeastern North Carolina and may bring life-threatening storm surge to Dare County, along with tropical storm force winds and heavy rains.

Due to these new developments; we are sad to realize no other option than to cancel the Outer Banks Triathlon scheduled for September 14-16, 2018.

We certainly wish the timing was different and will be in touch after the event date as to any special pricing offers for Outer Banks Triathlon 2019 registration
