Linda was also part of a team of three residents that first delivered meals to residents of Waite Park with the Meals on Wheels program. Linda was an integral help with the Waite Park Centennial Celebration! She did extensive research of the history of the village, and its residents, and by searching county records, Linda determined the oldest house on each block, so that each of these homeowners would have a sign in front of their home during the Centennial Celebration. Linda also contributed information, which was included in the centennial book that was dedicated to the city titled *Between Rails and Rocks: 100 Years on Waite Park*.

Volunteering has been such a big part of Linda's life. She will tell you that she has received much more than she has given. Lifelong friendships and memories through the gift of service has been the bigger reward.
