Thank you for registering as a delegate for the Movement Day Africa gathering. This document has all the important information you will need to plan your trip to Nairobi, Kenya.

Registration

To register as a delegate for the Movement Day Africa Conference, each delegate has to pay 20 US\$ as a registration fee. This fee ensures your place at the conference and includes a light lunch for the two days.

Visa Requirements for Travel to Kenya

Each participant should ensure they have secured all necessary travel documents and visas.

E-visa application

Yellow Fever Vaccination Certificates

A Yellow Fever vaccination certificate is required for all visitors coming from countries that have a risk of Yellow Fever transmission. It is, however, advisable that all foreign travellers obtain the vaccination and carry the card, even if for re-entry into your home country.

It is ultimately the responsibility of every participant to identify and obtain all required documentation for the trip.

Kenya, Nairobi - What to expect

About Nairobi

Nairobi is the capital and largest city of Kenya. Nairobi is situated between the cities of Kampala and Mombasa. The Ngong Hills, located to the west of the city, are the most prominent geographical feature of the Nairobi area. Mount Kenya is situated north of Nairobi, and Mount Kilimanjaro is towards the south-east.

Weather and Climate

Nairobi has a subtropical highland climate and evenings may be cool, especially in the June/July season, when the temperature can drop to 9 °C (48 °F). The sunniest and warmest part of the year is from December to March, when temperatures average the mid-twenties during the day. The mean maximum temperature for this period is 24 °C (75 °F). During the month of August when the conference is taking place, the daily high temperatures increase from 22 °C (72°F) to 24 °C (74°F), rarely falling below 18 °C (66°F) or exceeding 26 °C (79°F).

Currency

The currency in Kenya is the Kenyan Shilling. If you are using the United States Dollar, you do not need to exchange dollars to the Kenyan Shilling. The Dollar is accepted in Kenya to make payments.

Travel

On registration, please indicate whether you will need assistance from the host team to arrange any of these services for you. Delegates are, however, free to make their own arrangements for airport transfer and/or hotel accommodation.

Airport Transfer

Transport from the airport to a hotel is 60 US\$ per person. You can only pick this option if you are also seeking the host team's help in booking accommodation.

Accommodation

There are various options when it comes to accommodation to choose from. The list below is of hotels that are close to the venue of the conference. The host team will only take responsibility for accommodation in any one of these pre-identified hotels/guest houses. Any participant who needs accommodation arranged for them will need to choose the preferred facility as well as their anticipated number of nights, and the cost will be calculated based on this. The costs indicated are for bed & breakfast.
