AmeriCorps members across the country are dedicating a year to doing full-time to service in their communities.

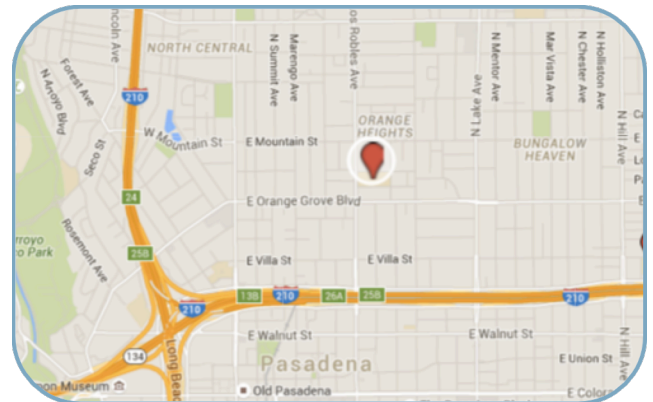
