HOW WE OPERATE

MOW doesn't receive any federal or state funding, so we rely on the generosity of donors to help fund nearly two thirds of our costs. We charge only \$2 for lunch and \$4 for dinner to keep our program affordable for those on a fixed income, and we haven't raised our fees in over eight years. We keep costs low with only five part-time employees who work with our dedicated corps of 140+ volunteers to prepare, package and deliver the meals. And we receive in-kind donations of goods and services from many businesses, civic organizations and individuals (see "It Takes a Village" on the inside).

Volunteer Spotlight

SONIA KRISHNA, a former teacher, came to MOW delivering meals with her daughter through NCL (National Charity League). "I used to watch the kitchen when I came to get the food, and wish I could join them," says Sonia. "There was just so much energy." Now, five years later, not only did she get her wish, but she also has a big responsibility: Sonia makes sure all of Friday's meals are packed and labeled correctly, and that there are no issues with allergies or other dietary restraints.

"I started subbing in the kitchen, and when a spot opened up, I said yes. I love it!" Sonia comes in every Thursday for an hour or two to get organized, and then from early Friday morning until the food goes out, she and everyone else in the kitchen work non-stop. "It's a good kind of chaos," says Sonia. One of her favorite things about being a volunteer is the friends she's made. "A couple of us knit, and for a while, a group of us played bridge. We have a lot of fun."

Sonia still likes to make deliveries with her daughter, who is now in high school. "It's one activity the both of us love doing together. It's so nice to meet the clients, and to understand that there is a real need in Ridgefield for MOW."

DEBRA FRANCESCHINI-GATJE has been on the board of MOW for two years and is responsible for outreach and events. In 2018, she put together a "MOW road show" to present to community organizations across Ridgefield in order to broaden the reach of MOW and serve more clients in need. "We wanted to tell people we aren't just for seniors," says Deb. "We can also help a parent who injured themselves and can't cook, or someone with an illness who needs short-term help. As a result, we've seen a tremendous increase in client meals."

Deb also organizes fundraising events and is the point person for schools, scout troops and businesses who want to contribute special decorated bags, holiday treats, or other gifts. Beyond MOW, Deb is also involved with Senior Positive Initiative Forum and the Commission on Aging. She says these roles help her understand the wider needs of many of our clients.

Deb has extensive experience in the corporate world until serious health issues forced her to stop work. Early retirement was never her plan, but becoming a board member has allowed her to find a meaningful role. She says that her experience was perhaps "God's way of pointing me in a direction where I could be helpful and make a difference."

"The Soup Guys"



Once the weather starts to get cold, MOW adds a popular item to the menu: soup! But making it is not easy as you might think. Not all soups are healthy, and it can be tricky to get the quantities right. But, as is so often the case, some amazing people stepped up to help. Four volunteers, all men, get together every week to prepare nourishing and delicious soups like cream of asparagus, chicken tortellini and black bean.

They all have different backgrounds and didn't know each other before volunteering, but now love working together as a team and have earned the nickname "the Soup Guys." FRANK RAMOS, a retired firefighter, is used to making soup in large quantities. His specialty? "The Firehouse Italian Wedding soup is my favorite." And he adds, laughing: "Even though these guys complain about making the little tiny meatballs."

TIM FARROW is a graphic designer who freelances from home and makes time in his schedule for MOW. ANDREW ULICKY lives in South Salem and is a retired cabinet maker. One thing they both have in common? They are the cooks of the family. "My wife burns water," says Andrew. CHRIS ORLOW is also a graphic designer, but is thinking about starting up a food business. They have all learned a lot about cooking, have fun and enjoy giving back to the community.

When CHRIS NOLAN found out she needed complex foot surgery that would mean weeks off her feet, she wasn't sure that MOW was right for her. "I thought you had to sign up for the long term. I had no idea it was something you could do for a few weeks." Chris, who was the Director of the Ridgefield Library for 16 years until retiring three years ago, signed up to get deliveries for six weeks after her surgery last November.

She says that not having to worry about shopping and cooking, as well as the quality of the meals she received, made a big difference to her recovery. "When you're home alone and it's hard to manage, you make poor nutrition choices. But with MOW, there's salad, there's fruit, there is a real variety of food. It's just terrific." Something else that was a bonus? "I enjoyed the little messages on the bags- those little pick-me-ups can go a long way."

Chris has had orthopedic surgeries before and wishes she had known then that MOW was an option during those recoveries. "It was hard for me to manage. I was living on my own, and without being able to walk, I couldn't manage my kitchen. This really worked out great. I hope other people realize it's an option in case they need it."



MARIE ADAMS enjoys her morning routine: an early church service, followed by breakfast at Steve's Bagels. She has lived in Ridgefield since 1975, and now has an apartment in the center of town. She lives on her own, but has family not too far away. When she is out and about, she enjoys being social. "I always try to make a connection with someone," she says. "It's a small world."

Her son was a volunteer driver several years ago, but she only started receiving meals after she had hip replacement surgery. "I love it, and I never stopped. I only get two deliveries a week, which is perfect for me. Then I don't need to cook as much, and I enjoy going out to eat as well. But being my age, things pop up. It's nice to know that it's there when I need it."

While salmon is her favorite MOW entree, she says she has never been disappointed in any of the meals. "My friends think I'm getting a sandwich and a glass of milk. I tell them that if they saw what I was eating, they would move here!"

Marie has a message for the children who decorate the bags the meals come in: "I hope those kids realize that we love those bags. I always appreciate the decoration and I reuse them."



Total donations decreased slightly. While we experienced strong growth in donations from individuals and foundations, annual appeal donations were lower


than in 2017.
