Enjoy the Rally Experience



SPECTATOR AREAS 1 & 2 WILDCAT STAGE (SS-2, SS-4) SATURDAY, MAY 19

Stage information

This stage is a favorite with the drivers, but a marathon for the co-driver with miles of tight and twisty roads. This makes for a long list of notes!

It's said the competitors can see their own tail lights in the switchbacks.

This is the longest stage of the Rally.

Wildcat is ran twice in the same direction.

The first car out for the first running is at 10:53 and 2:18 for the second.

Important!

This Spectator area will not open until 8 AM.

Area 1 is a stage locked location. Meaning once you enter this area you are to remain here until the end of the second running.

There may not be any time between runnings for exit.

Please be prepared for this if you choose to come to this location.

The parking location for area 1 will be closed at 9:35. No exceptions.

There will be a porta potty near area 1 parking and the gravel pit.



DIRECTIONS

From Exposé to Wildcat Spectator Stage (33 min)

1. Depart S 4th St toward W Cota St	
2. Turn left onto W Cota St	
3. Turn right onto WA-3 / S 1st St	
4. Keep right onto Pioneer Way, Pizza Hut on the corner	
5. Road name changes to Lake Blvd	
6. Road name changes to W Cloquallum Rd	
7. Turn left onto W Bulb Farm Rd	
8. Continue down Bulb Farm Rd until you reach a	
Rally Marshal to give you parking Instruction.

The first car out for the first running is at 5:47 and 6:18 for the second.

Do not climb on any of the logs and equipment.

Stay in the designated areas at all times. No exceptions.



DIRECTIONS

From Wildcat Spectator Stage to Simpson Super Special (31 min)

1. Depart W Bulb Farm Rd toward W Cloquallum Rd 1.1 mi

2. Turn left onto W Cloquallum Rd 1.6 mi

3. Turn right onto W Highland Rd 7.9 mi

4. Turn left onto W Shelton Matlock Rd 2.4 mi

This is also the Olympus Rally finish location and where awards will be presented to the Olympus Rally Victors! Make sure to stick around and watch!

Stage length is only 14.1 Miles.

The first car out for the first running is at 11:09 and 1:54 for the second.

This Spectator area will not open until 9:30am.


Do not climb on any of the logs and equipment.

From the Shelton Matlock Exit of HWY 101

- 1. Take the Shelton Matlock Rd exit of HWY 101 and take a left.
- 2. Follow Shelton Matlock Rd for 8.4 miles and take a right at the spectator entrance.
- 3. A Rally Marshal will be there to give you parking instruction.
