2018 Senior Instructor Expressions of Interest

As explained in the recent Green & White Broadsheet we have made a number of changes to the way Member Development will operate moving forward. These include:

- Existing SRC holders now no longer need to complete the full Bronze Medallion Course. Instead only need to complete the units not covered in the SRC program and the full Bronze Assessment.
- As part of the Bronze Medallion course (including the SRC Upskill detailed above) we can now also deliver the IRB Crew person course.
- We had expected significant increases in accommodation costs if we continued in the same format for the Bronze camp as previous. By utilising the club for the bronze camp and also for the planned upskill SRV camps we will deliver a much lower cost program which will also overcome restricted access by some members, to the previous bronze camps, due to members financial limitation.
- Importantly it has been getting more and more difficult to source the appropriate number of trainers for the combined program. Add to this the mixed skill sets that exist between new club members (with limited or potentially no surf water skills) and existing SRC members with high level surf water skills. This new approach allows us to focus our training for the SRC members on the new skill sets rather than repeating the skills gained in completing the SRC.

Please remember that all trainers are required to train each season to ensure that their training (TOC) qualification remains current. We really appreciate you all to assist across all of our camps and courses.

Camps:

Considering the above factors, the camps/courses will be as follows in 2018/19:

Mandatory requirements of all Senior Instructors

- Bronze Snr Instructors: Hold a current Training Officers Certificate (Bronze), Bronze Medallion, Senior First Aid Certificate and at least one other certificate.
- IRBD Snr Instructor: Hold a current Training Officers Certificate (IRB), Bronze Medallion, IRBD, current marine licence and at least one other certificate
- First Aid Snr Instructor: Hold a current Training Officers Certificate (First Aid), Bronze Medallion, Senior First Aid Certificate and at least one other certificate
- ART Snr Instructor: Hold a current Training Officers Certificate (ART), Bronze Medallion, Senior First Aid Certificate, Advanced Resuscitation Techniques Certificate and at least one other certificate (and have requalified all awards prior to coming to camp)
- Spinal Snr Instructor: Hold a current Training Officers Certificate (Spinal), Bronze Medallion, Senior First Aid Certificate, Spinal Management Certificate and at least one other certificate (and have requalified all awards prior to coming to camp)
- Be a financial member of Anglesea SLSC (if over 18, must also hold a Working with Children Check)
- Be previous member of Anglesea for at least three seasons
- Have completed a minimum of 20 patrol hours in the previous season, of which 50% must be on-beach (not nipper water safety) patrol hours at Anglesea beach
- Be available for the entire camp/course/s applied for
- Be a current member of an ASR (preferred)
- Attend the pre-Course/Camp Senior Instructor Briefing Session on the date designated for that program.



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Application Criteria:

- Level of involvement in the club (e.g. patrol, competition, nippers, training, major fundraisers)
- Depth of knowledge of the subject matter (e.g. Bronze, IRBD, FAC)
- Ability to provide availability to train at least two courses/camps in the 2018/2019 season.

Roles & Responsibilities

Senior Instructors will be responsible for the following on all camps/courses:

- The preparation and delivery of course materials/equipment to candidates.
- To lead the instruction of candidates with the support of the Trainee Trainers (TOC's) to the required standard.
- To mentor Trainee Trainers (TOC's).
- To ensure the safety of all candidates and Trainee Trainers in your group.
- To ensure that the appropriate water safety requirements are in place for all water sessions, including the completion of Aquatic Risk Assessment for each water training session.
- To assist with the pastoral care and member welfare of all camp/course participants.
- To ensure that the club and beach are kept clean and tidy at all times.
- To act in the best interest of the club at all times.
- To report any member safety concerns, OH&S issues, equipment maintenance issues and all incidents to the Head of Camp/Course in a timely manner.
- To follow and enforce all Australian laws and SLSA, LSV and Club policies.
- To perform first aid duties as required.
