Gin producer Andrew Arnold-Bennett

Actor Andrew Arnold-Bennett has taken on a new role as a gin producer.

Andrew has launched Shed 1 Distillery, a micro gin distillery named after the brick and stone building at his Ulverston home where he's set up the business.

After a successful 20-year career including work with theatre company Northern Broadsides and appearances at the Globe in London plus tours to American and South Korea, Andrew wanted a job which

didn't take him far from home.

He sources base alcohol from large distillers then adds his own recipe of botanicals before distilling the mixture to make his gins.

He has so far launched Cuckold's Revenge, Giggle in the Ginnel and Festive Tipple.

Andrew, who is married to Zoe, will be selling the gin at the Ulverston Dickensian Christmas Festival on November 26 and 27, at Virginia House Restaurant with Rooms in the town and via www.shed1distillery.com.
