IMPORTANT INFORMATION WHEN PLANNING YOUR VISIT

All visitors over 18 years of age must provide valid photo identification to access the PMA.

Acceptable forms of civilian identification

The following forms of photographic identification are the only accepted identity cards that may be submitted as a form of positive identification for civilians to gain access to the Puckapunyal Military Area, supported by the issue of an appropriate temporary access card:

- a. A current valid photographic licence or permit issued by the Commonwealth of Australia, state or territory government such as a driver's licence issued in Australia.
- b. A current passport.
- c. A current valid Proof of Age card, as issued by a state transport authority.
- d. A current valid key pass identity card.
- e. A current valid photographic employee identity card issued by the Commonwealth of Australia, state, territory or local government such as Comcare, fire service or Mitchell Shire.

Groups that contain members under 18 years of age must be accompanied by one adult supervisor per 20 visitors. Please note the adults will require photographic identification.

The Puckapunyal Military Area (PMA) is located in a high Bushfire Danger area, during Extreme or Code Red FDR Days only essential personal will be allowed access to the PMA. The general public will not be able to gain access to the museum.
