1. To fulfil the ACC five-fold Mission Statement.
2. The application should benefit at least two Tikanga and demonstrate that it is consistent with their respective strategic plans.
3. To give effect to the will of General Synod/te Hīnota Whānui.
4. To encourage applications for new and existing projects working across the Church, and be open to innovative possibilities and new initiatives.
5. To build leadership capability for growth and mission in areas which might include: General Ministry, Under 40's, Family and Children, Evangelism.
6. To encourage beneficiaries of funding to achieve financial sustainability through exploration of alternative funding sources.

TIKANGA MAORI 2016 - 2025

1. Strengthening the proclamation of the Good News of God's Kingdom to whanau, hapu and iwi in Hui Amorangi and encouraging communications that support proclamation and outreach
2. Identifying and nurturing a new generation of leaders including nga Kahui
3. Honouring, inspiring, encouraging, empowering and equipping of Minita-a-Whanau and Minita-a-Iwi to provide ministry within Hui Amorangi
4. Focusing on the offering of high quality theological education and ministry formation which maintains and advances Mihingaretanga
5. Creating and delivering excellent Mihingare education for tamariki, rangatahi and whanau including at Mihingare schools
6. Enhancing the Episcopal teaching and proclamation of the Christian faith
7. Supporting the co-ordination and development of educational provision across Te Pihopatanga o Aotearoa
8. Focusing on high quality research which maintains and advances Mihingaretanga
9. Developing relationships by sharing our unique Mihingare experience and knowledge with other Maori and other indigenous peoples of the world
10. Developing annual Hui Amorangi operational plans that include robust monitoring and evaluation processes that support this strategic plan and its priority areas
11. Actively contributing on matters of structural injustice and social problems in Aotearoa to add a distinctive Mihingare perspective on social justice issues
12. Promoting our moral responsibility to respect and protect God's creation through the delivery of wananga developing our theology of creation that will shape our commitment to care for the environment
