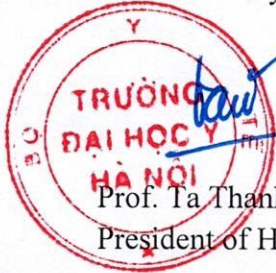

APPENDIX 1: Guidelines for Speaker(s)/Presenter(s)

1. General requirements:

For presenters, please kindly submit a summary of the scientific report (Abstract) and send with the registration form (Appendix 2 attached) to the Conference email hnhk2020@gmail.com; or the official conference website.

- Abstract is requested to submit by deadline.
- Abstract is requested to send to the email address: hnhk2020@gmail.com or to the official conference website.
- The abbreviations in the article must be annotated with the original words.

2. Instruction for preparing of the abstract and research paper:

a. Title of the abstract presentation:

- Title of the presentation should be written in Vietnamese or English language, no more than 30 words, without punctuation at the end of the title, using Times New Roman font (unicode system), font size 14, bold, lowercase.
- Full name of author, specifying workplace, title, degree, phone number and email contact.

b. Content:

- The abstract should be presented in a 500 words limitation, and should include: Objectives, subjects, research methods, research results and conclusions. At the end of the summary, it should be noted with five (5) keywords for lookup, each keyword is no longer than five (5) words or phrases.
- For those presenters who wish to submit the research paper for publishing in the Journal of Practice Medicine, please kindly follow the below instruction:

The research paper should be in fulltext word format and limited to 3,500 words. The full text must include the following components:

- Summary
- Introduction including research objectives and questions
- Subjects and research methods
- Research results
- Discussion
- Conclusions
- References: Arrange references by the order they appear in the article.
