### Prayer for Healing

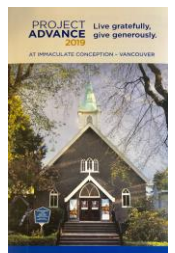


Dear Lord of Mercy, God of healing,
