Next week, every parishioner is invited to come and celebrate our annual ‘40 Hour Devotion’ – Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday from 7:30 in the morning until 9:30pm at night. Come for 15 minutes or an hour – steward your time and choose to make time with the Lord. This Devotion celebrates Jesus present in the Eucharist – Jesus desiring to be with us.

For this Devotion the Blessed Sacrament is placed in a Monstrance (a special vessel designed to hold the round host) so that the ‘Sacred Host’ may be easily seen and venerated. The Monstrance is placed on the Altar. It is surrounded with candles to highlight that something sacred is before us. Through this Devotion we enter into sacred space and the holy presence of God. The Devotion focuses our attention upon Jesus – Jesus present among us in the Blessed Sacrament (Eucharist). It is an experience of ‘Contemplative Prayer’ – we simply choose to make ourselves present to the Real Presence of Jesus in the Eucharist. In an era where we all spend so much time with technology and in cyber space this Devotion becomes a restorative experience for the human heart, mind and soul. It is a grace filled time – a time to just be – to be with our self in the loving presence of God.

In our world it is very challenging for us to become still... yet to choose to steward our time to be with Jesus in the Eucharist is to discover delight in stillness – a delight which leads us to be at home within ourselves, with God and in life itself. Everyone in the Parish is invited to come this week to be with the Lord – our school children and staff, high school kids, university students, mom, dad, siblings...Come be with the Lord and tell him what is going on in your mind, heart and soul.


